On September 3, 2009, an application was filed by Lattice Incorporated, (Applicant) of Pennsauken, New Jersey, seeking authority to operate as an operator services provider and resale carrier of intrastate interlata and intralata telecommunications services and inmate operator services within the State of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on September 4, 2009. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

Applicant is a privately held corporation, organized under the laws of the State of Delaware since May 1973. Applicant has been authorized by the Secretary of State to operate in Nebraska as a foreign corporation. In addition, no officer, director or shareholder having five percent or more of the applicant's voting securities has been involved in a formal complaint or other investigatory or enforcement proceeding.

Applicant is a switchless, non-facilities-based reseller of telecommunications services provided over the networks of certified underlying carriers. Applicant proposes to offer telecommunications service from originating points throughout the State of Nebraska, which may terminate to any valid NPA-NXX within the state. Intrastate service will be offered in conjunction with interstate service.

Interexchange applications are subject to Commission jurisdiction under Neb. Rev. Stat. § 86-129 and Title 291 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, Chapter 5, Rule 003.12. From examination of the application filed herein, the Commission finds Applicant has provided all the information required by the Commission, possesses adequate financial resources to provide the proposed service, and possesses adequate technical

competency to provide the proposed service. A grant of the application will serve the public interest. Accordingly, the application should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Docket C-4207 be, and it is hereby, granted and Lattice Incorporated, is authorized to provide interexchange telecommunications services within the State of Nebraska.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, to the extent applicable, the applicant shall comply with all laws pertaining to, and all rules and regulations promulgated under, the Telecommunications Relay System Act (Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 86-301 to 86-315) and the Nebraska Telecommunications Universal Service Fund Act (Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 86-316 to 86-329).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within **30 days** from the entry date of this order that the Applicant file a tariff and pay appropriate filing fees with the Commission as required by state statutes and the Commission's regulations.

IT IS FINALLY ORDERED that this order be, and it is hereby made, the Commission's official certificate of authority to furnish the service authorized herein as a common carrier.
