On October 5, 2009, the Commission docketed a request by United Way of the Midlands based on a requests from Volunteers of America - Western Nebraska in Lewellen, Nebraska, Community Action Partnership of Mid-Nebraska in North Platte, Nebraska, Furnas County Office of Emergency Management in Beaver City, Nebraska, and the Norfolk Area United Way, Inc. in Norfolk, Nebraska, for use of "211" as the dialing code for First Call for Help (FCFH) services in the following counties in Nebraska: Greeley, Loup, Wheeler, Garfield, Furnas, Lincoln, Garden, Keith, Deuel, and Cheyenne.
