BY THE COMMISSION:

On October 11, 2011, an application was filed by IntelePeer, Inc., ("IntelePeer" or "Applicant") of San Mateo, California, seeking approval of certain pro forma intra-corporate transaction. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on October 14, 2011. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

The Applicant:

IntelePeer is a Delaware corporation headquartered in San Mateo, California. IntelePeer is authorized to provide resold and facilities-based local exchange, access and interexchange telecommunications services in the State of Nebraska under and by virtue of authority heretofore granted by this Commission¹.

Description of the Transactions:

Applicant proposes to complete a series of pro forma intra-corporate transactions. First, one or more holding companies will be inserted between IntelePeer and its current direct shareholders. Second, moves IntelePeer's subsidiary, IntelePeer Virginia, Inc. under the new holding company or holding companies, making IntelePeer Virginia, Inc. an affiliate of IntelePeer instead of a subsidiary. Finally, assign certain assets of IntelePeer to one or more affiliates.

The Applicant states in its application that the insertion of a holding company or holding companies in the ownership chain of IntelePeer will not affect the ultimate

ownership or control of IntelePeer nor change the management and day-to-day operations in Nebraska. Further, the Applicant states the transfer of assets will not result in the transfer of any customers or IntelePeer's authority to provide telecommunications services. IntelePeer will continue to operate the assigned assets even though it will no longer hold legal title to the assets.

The Applicant submits that the public interest is served because the proposed transactions will ensure that IntelePeer's customers continue to enjoy high quality services. Further, IntelePeer states the transactions will enable the Applicant to undertake equity and debt financing transactions in the future to improve the focus of its operations. The transactions will be seamless to customers and not result in any changes in service, transfer of customers or certificates of authority, or changes in the ultimate ownership of IntelePeer or its assets.

Based on the evidence, we find the application to be fair and reasonable and in the public interest. The application should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-4229.1 be, and it is hereby, approved.
