BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 26, 2010, an application was filed by Discount Long Distance, LLC (Applicant), Oakdale, Minnesota, seeking authority to operate as an interexchange carrier of telecommunications services within the State of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 30, 2010. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's rule of modified procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Applicant is a limited liability company, organized under the laws of the State of Minnesota since November 16, 2009. Applicant has been authorized by the Secretary of State to operate in Nebraska as a foreign limited liability company. In addition, no officer, director or shareholder having five percent or more of the Applicant's voting securities has been involved in a formal complaint or other investigatory or enforcement proceeding.

Applicant is a switchless, non-facilities based interexchange resale carrier providing switched and dedicated interexchange telecommunications services to business and residential customers. Applicant seeks authority to be a non-facilities based interexchange telecommunications carrier in the State of Nebraska, with all network services provided by Sprint or other facilities-based carriers. Applicant would be solely dependent on the technical capabilities of its underlying carrier. Applicant proposes to offer switched and dedicated access and 1+ long distance telecommunications services suitable for voice and limited data applications in the State of Nebraska. Applicant does not propose to provide alternative operator services or require advanced payment options or deposits.

Interexchange applications are subject to Commission jurisdiction under Neb. Rev. Stat. § 86-129 and Title 291 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, Chapter 5, Rule 003.12. From examination of the application filed herein, the Commission finds that Applicant has provided all the information required by the Commission, possesses adequate financial resources to provide the proposed service, and possesses adequate technical competency to provide the proposed service. The application should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-4263 be, and it is hereby, granted and Discount Long Distance, LLC is authorized to operate as an interexchange carrier of telecommunications services within the State of Nebraska.


