On March 30, 2010, an application was filed by NebraskaLink, LLC (Applicant), Aurora, seeking authority to operate as an interexchange carrier of telecommunications services within the State of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on April 6, 2010. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's rule of modified procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

Applicant is a limited liability company, organized under the laws of the State of Nebraska since February 23, 2010. Applicant is authorized to transact business in the State of Nebraska. In addition, no officer, director or shareholder having five percent or more of the Applicant's voting securities has been involved in a formal complaint or other investigatory or enforcement proceeding.

Applicant is a new entity, seeking authority to be an interexchange telecommunications carrier in the Applicant's affiliated entities currently provide Nebraska. exchange and interexchange telecommunications local services as well as broadband services in the State of Nebraska. Applicant proposes to construct a middle mile network consisting of a fiber optic cable backbone with numerous components to provide Internet bandwidth to Internet service providers and and interexchange private line special access services. Applicant does not propose to require advanced payments or deposits.

Interexchange applications are subject to Commission jurisdiction under Neb. Rev. Stat. § 86-129 and Title 291 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, Chapter 5, Rule 003.12. From examination of the application filed herein, the Commission finds that Applicant has provided all the information required by the Commission, possesses adequate financial resources to provide the proposed service, and possesses adequate technical

competency to provide the proposed service. The application should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-4264 be, and it is hereby, granted and NebraskaLink, LLC is authorized to operate as an interexchange carrier of telecommunications services within the State of Nebraska.
