On August 27, 2010, an application was filed by Opex Communications, Inc. ("Opex") of Los Angeles, California, seeking authority to add TCI Long Distance as a trade name. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on September 1, 2010. No protests were filed; therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N     A N D     F I N D I N G S

Opex is a corporation with its principal offices located at 707 Wilshire Blvd., 12<sup>th</sup> Floor, Los Angeles, California 90017. Opex operates pursuant to a certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by this Commission November 24, 1998 under Docket C-1911 and is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.

In the present application, Opex requests that the Commission enter an order approving the addition by Opex of the trade name "TCI Long Distance". Opex has received authority from the Secretary of State to use the new name. The adoption of the new name will have no effect on the rates, terms or conditions of Opex's provision of telecommunications services to its customers. Based on all the evidence adduced, the Commission is of the opinion the application is in the public interest and should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-4299 be, and it is hereby, granted and the request of Opex Communications, Inc. is approved.


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
