BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed June 21, 2011, Alltel Communications, Inc. (Alltel), Alpharetta, Georgia, seeks approval of an amendment to the Wireless Interconnection and Reciprocal Compensation Agreement with Hamilton Telecommunications (Hamilton), Aurora, Nebraska, previously granted in Docket C-3178. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on June 27, 2011. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(a) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), Alltel and Hamilton (parties) entered into a Wireless Interconnection and Reciprocal Compensation Agreement arrived at through voluntary negotiations and previously granted in Docket C-3178. The parties now wish to amend the agreement further through an amendment. An executed copy of this amendment is contained within the application.

Neither the amendment nor any portion thereof discriminates against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review interconnection agreements adopted by negotiation or arbitration to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment to the Wireless

Interconnection and Reciprocal Compensation Agreement should be approved.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the amendment between Alltel Communications, Inc., Alpharetta, Georgia, and Hamilton Telecommunications, Aurora, Nebraska, be, and it is hereby, approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the executed interconnection amendment filed herein be, and it is hereby, made the official copy on file with the Nebraska Public Service Commission.

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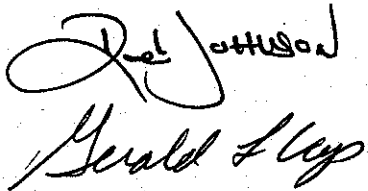
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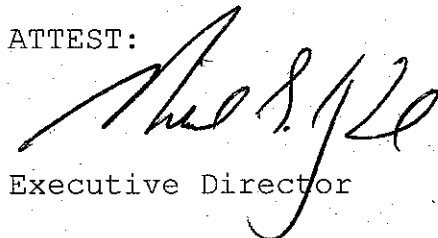
