BY THE COMMISSION:

On July 14, 2011, an application was filed by Clara Rolfes of Wynot, Nebraska, seeking authority for a boundary change to receive telephone service from the adjacent Obert exchange of Northeast Nebraska Telephone Company, ("NNTC") in lieu of her current telephone service from Great Plains Communications ("GP"). Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on July 18, 2011.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

NNTC and GP are local exchange carriers holding certificates of public convenience and necessity to provide local exchange service in their respective territories. Ms. Rolfes resides within the boundaries of GP's exchange, and has requested a boundary change so that she may receive local exchange service from NNTC. GP has notified the Commission that it does not oppose the proposed boundary change. A legal description of the location at which service is requested from NNTC was included with the application.

Changes of a local exchange territory are governed by Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 86-135 to 86-138. Section 86-135 states that only upon non-consent of all telephone carriers involved shall the Commission hold a public hearing in the application. With no protest filed by any party and with each of the affected local exchange carriers consenting to the boundary change, the Commission processes this application administratively and without a public hearing.

The Commission finds that, in light of the agreement between all parties involved, the application is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-4394 be, and it is hereby, granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Northeast Nebraska Telephone Company and Great Plains Communications submit revised boundary maps to the Commission within 30 days from the date of this order.
