BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed July 18, 2011, Qwest Corporation (Qwest), Denver, Colorado, seeks approval of an amendment to the wireless interconnection agreement with Sprint Spectrum, L.P. (Sprint), of Overland Park, Kansas, previously granted in Docket C-2768. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on July 21, 2011. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(a) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), Qwest and Sprint (parties) entered into a wireless interconnection agreement arrived at through voluntary negotiations and previously granted in Docket C-2768. The parties now wish to amend the agreement further through a rate amendment. An executed copy of this amendment is contained within the application.

Neither the amendment nor any portion thereof discriminates against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review interconnection agreements adopted by negotiation or arbitration to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment to the wireless interconnection agreement should be approved.
