BY THE COMMISSION:

On August 25, 2011, an application was filed by Business Telecom, Inc. ("Business Telecom" or "Applicant") of Grand Rapids, Michigan, seeking approval of a name change to Earthlink Business III. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on August 29, 2011. No protests were filed; therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Business Telecom is a Georgia corporation with its principal offices located at 2610 Horizon Drive SE, Suite B, Grand Rapids, MI 49546. Business Telecom operates pursuant to a certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by this Commission on April 23, 1996, in Docket C-1245 and is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.

In the present application, Business Telecom requests that the Commission enter an order approving the adoption by Business Telecom of the name "Earthlink Business III". Business Telecom has received authority from the Secretary of State to use the new name. The adoption of the new name will have no effect on the rates, terms or conditions of Business Telecom's provision of telecommunications services to its customers. Based on all the evidence adduced, the Commission is of the opinion the application is in the public interest and should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-4408 be, and it is hereby, granted and the request of Business Telecom to add a trade name of Earthlink Business III is approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Applicant file an updated tariff reflecting the change in name within 30 days of the date of this order.
