BY THE COMMISSION:

On December 27, 2011, an application was filed by 1 800 Collect, Inc., (Applicant) of San Diego, California, seeking authority to operate as a resale carrier of intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in the State of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on January 2, 2012. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Applicant is a privately held corporation, organized under the laws of the State of Florida since November 12, 1993. Applicant has been authorized by the Secretary of State to operate in Nebraska as a foreign corporation. In addition, no officer, director or shareholder having five percent or more of the Applicant's voting securities has been involved in a formal complaint or other investigatory or enforcement proceeding.

Applicant is a reseller of telecommunications services provided over the networks of its underlying carriers. Applicant proposes to offer alternate operator switched and dedicated switched interexchange telecommunications services to all persons or businesses desiring to purchase its service in the State of Nebraska. Applicant will handle operator-assisted calls, such as collect, third party billed, person-to-person and credit card calls from payphone locations and other traffic aggregator locations, such as hotels and hospitals. Applicant will not provide service to correctional/confinement facilities.

Interexchange applications are subject to Commission jurisdiction under Neb. Rev. Stat. § 86-129 and Title 291 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, Chapter 5, Rule 003.12. From examination of the application filed herein, the Commission finds Applicant has provided all the information required by the Commission, possesses adequate financial resources to provide the proposed service, and possesses adequate technical

competency to provide the proposed service. A grant of the application will serve the public interest. Accordingly, the application should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-4435 be, and it is hereby granted and 1 800 Collect, Inc., is authorized to provide resold interexchange telecommunications services within the State of Nebraska.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, to the extent applicable, Applicant shall comply with all laws pertaining to, and all rules and regulations promulgated under, the Telecommunications Relay System Act (Neb. Rev. Stat. §§86-301 to 86-315) and the Nebraska Telecommunications Universal Service Fund Act (Neb. Rev. Stat. §§86-316 to 86-329).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Applicant file its current tariff prior to offering service pursuant to the certificate granted in this order.

IT IS FINALLY ORDERED that this order be, and it is hereby made the Commission's official certificate of authority to furnish the service authorized herein as a common carrier.






