## BY THE COMMISSION:

March 2, 2012, Benkelman Telephone Co., Inc. ("Benkelman") Benkelman, Nebraska, gave written notice to the Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission") and customers of its intent to increase its rates for basic local telephone service pursuant to the Nebraska Telecommunications Regulation Act ("The Act"). On March 19, 2012, the Commission received a written request from Benkelman seeking a review by the Commission of Benkelman's proposed rates. Benkelman's proposed rate increase is related to similar rate increases by Wauneta Telephone Co. (Wauneta) and Hartman Telephone Exchanges, Inc., (Hartman) which received the requisite petitions from five-percent (5%) of the affected customers to Commission review pursuant to statute. As of the date of this order, the number of petitions from Benkelman customers has not reached the five-percent (5%) threshold. However, in the event threshold is reached, Benkelman desires to initiate Commission review concurrently with Wauneta and Hartman to save time and resources.

Therefore, pursuant to the Act, the Commission notified the company that pursuant to its request, the Commission would hold a hearing to gather evidence to conduct a review of whether the proposed rates are fair, just, and reasonable. The review was docketed by the Commission as Docket No. C-4450.
