BY THE COMMISSION:

On May 31, 2012, an application was filed by Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink QC, (CenturyLink) of Denver, Colorado, seeking approval of an ICC Bill and Keep Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement with USA Mobility Wireless, Inc. (USA Mobility), Plano, Texas, (collectively, the "Parties"). Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on June 6, 2012. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Pursuant to Section 252(a) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), the Parties entered into an Interconnection Agreement (Agreement) for service in the State of Nebraska that was approved by the Nebraska Public Service Commission on September 12, 2006.¹

On May 10, 2012, the Parties agreed to an ICC Bill and Keep Amendment (Amendment) to the Interconnection Agreement. The Amendment is intended to amend the Agreement by adding the terms, conditions, and rates contained therein. This Amendment, upon approval by the Commission, will become a part of the Agreement.

Interexchange applications are subject to Commission jurisdiction under Neb. Rev. Stat. § 86-129 and Title 291 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, Chapter 5, Rule 003.12. Upon full consideration of the facts and circumstances, the Commission finds the Parties have provided all the information required by the Commission, that the Amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier and that it is consistent with the public interest.
