BY THE COMMISSION:

On September 10, 2012, an application was filed by Sprint Spectrum L.P. (Sprint) of Overland Park, Kansas, seeking approval of an Bill and Keep Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement with Nebraska Central Telephone Company (NCTC) of Gibbon, Nebraska (collectively, the "Parties"). Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on September 13, 2012. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Pursuant to Section 252(a) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), the Parties entered into an Interconnection Agreement (Agreement) for service in the State of Nebraska that was approved by the Nebraska Public Service Commission on December 2, 2003.¹

On July 11, 2012, the Parties agreed to a Bill and Keep Amendment (Amendment) to the Interconnection Agreement. The Amendment is intended to amend the Agreement by adding the terms, conditions, and rates contained therein. This Amendment, upon approval by the Commission, will become a part of the Agreement.

Interexchange applications are subject to Commission jurisdiction under Neb. Rev. Stat. § 86-129 and Title 291 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, Chapter 5, Rule 003.12. Upon full consideration of the facts and circumstances, the Commission finds the Parties have provided all the information required by the Commission, that the Amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier and that it
