On September 17, 2012, an application was filed by Dieca Communications, Inc. (Dieca), of San Jose, California, seeking approval to change its name to MegaPath Corporation (MegaPath). Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on September 20, 2012. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

Dieca is a privately held corporation, organized under the laws of the State of Virginia. Its principal place of business is San Jose, California. Dieca is authorized to provide local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska pursuant to the authority granted by this Commission on June 14, 2000, in Docket C-2241.

Dieca requests that the Commission enter an order approving the name change to "MegaPath Corporation." The converted entity has been registered with the Nebraska Secretary of State as a foreign corporation. The adoption of the new name will have no affect on rates, terms, or conditions of service offered to Nebraska customers.

Based on all the evidence adduced, the Commission is of the opinion the application is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-4519 be, and it is hereby, granted and the request of Dieca Communications,

Inc. to change its name to MegaPath Corporation is approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that MegaPath file its updated tariff reflecting the change in name within 30 days of the date of this order.
