BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed November 13, 2012, RRV Enterprises, Inc., (RRV) Houston, Texas, is seeking authority to withdraw its certificate of authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services in the State of Nebraska, previously approved in Docket C-1361. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on November 21, 2012. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

On September 17, 1996, RRV was granted authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services within the State of Nebraska pursuant to Docket C-1361.

By application received on November 13, 2012, RRV requested the withdrawal of its authority to operate as an interexchange carrier of telecommunications services in the State of Nebraska. RRV has no customers or facilities in Nebraska and provides no telecommunications service in Nebraska.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that RRV's authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services in the State of Nebraska should be cancelled and its tariffs withdrawn.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-4539 be, and it is hereby, granted and the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide interexchange telecommunications services previously granted to RRV Enterprises, Inc., is cancelled.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any interexchange tariff of RRV Enterprises, Inc. be, and is hereby, withdrawn.
