O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On January 11, 2013, Nebraska Technology & Telecommunications, Inc. (NT&T), of Omaha, Nebraska, filed an application seeking approval of an Interconnection Agreement with Windstream Nebraska Inc. (Windstream), of Little Rock, Arkansas. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on January 16, 2013. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(a) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), NT&T and Windstream entered into an Interconnection Agreement through voluntary negotiations. An executed copy of the agreement is contained within the application.

The agreement does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the Interconnection Agreement should be approved.
