BY THE COMMISSION:

On February 6, 2013, an application was jointly filed by AccessLine Communications Corp., ("AccessLine"), Telanetix, Inc., ("Telanetix"), both of Bellevue, Washington and Intermedia Holdings, Inc., ("Intermedia"), of Mountain View, California, all represented by counsel located in Washington D.C., (collectively "Applicants"), seeking approval of an indirect transfer of control of AccessLine from Telanetix to Intermedia. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on February 8, 2013. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N     A N D     F I N D I N G S

The Parties:

AccessLine is a Delaware corporation with principal offices located in Bellevue, Washington. AccessLine is authorized to provide interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska under and by virtue of authority heretofore granted by this Commission.<sup>1</sup> AccessLine is a wholly-owned subsidiary of AccessLine Holdings, Inc., which is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Telanetix.

Telanetix is a Delaware corporation with its principal place of business located in Bellevue, Washington. Telanetix is a provider of non-regulated services to business customers. Voice services, including Voice over Internet Protocol ("VoIP") services, are offered through its AccessLine subsidiary. Telanetix does not hold any authorizations relating to the provision of telecommunications services.

Intermedia is a Delaware corporation with its principal offices located in Mountain View, California. Intermedia's

primary shareholder is Oak Hill Capital Partners, a private equity firm. Intermedia is a provider of cloud services to small and mid-sized businesses. Intermedia's service offerings are not regulated telecommunications services and the company does not hold any authorizations relating the provision of telecommunications services.

Description of the Transaction:

According to the application, on January 18, 2013, Intermedia and Telanetix, entered into an Agreement and Plan of Merger whereby Intermedia will acquire control of Telanetix, and indirectly, AccessLine. As a result of the proposed transaction, AccessLine will become a wholly-owned indirect subsidiary of Intermedia.

Upon completion of the proposed transaction, the Applicants state AccessLine will continue to operate its facilities and provide service to its customers at the same rates, terms and conditions in Nebraska as it does currently. The Applicants state the transaction will be largely transparent to customers of both entities.

The Applicants state that the transaction is in the public interest and will increase competition in the Nebraska telecommunications market by reinforcing the status of AccessLine as a viable competitor and minimize the disruption of service and will be completely transparent to AccessLine customers.

Based on the evidence, we find the application to be fair and reasonable and in the public interest. The application should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-4584 be, and it is hereby, granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-4584 be, and it is hereby, granted.


