BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 28, 2013, a joint application was filed by Wholesale Carriers Services, Inc. ("WCS"), of Coral Springs, Florida, and Digizip.com, Inc. ("Digizip"), of Port Chester, New York (collectively referred to as "joint applicants"), seeking approval of an asset purchase agreement and transfer of customers. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on April 2, 2013. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

The Parties:

Wholesale Carrier Services, Inc. ("WCS") is a Florida corporation with principal offices located at 5471 North University Drive, Coral Springs, Florida. WCS has a certificate of public convenience and necessity to provide resold long distance and facilities-based local exchange telecommunications services in Nebraska pursuant to the authority granted in Docket C-3879 on December 18, 2007.

Digizip.com, Inc. ("Digizip") is an Arizona corporation with principal offices located at 168 Irving Avenue #302, Port Chester, New York. Digizip has a certificate of public convenience and necessity to provide resold long distance telecommunications services in Nebraska pursuant to the authority granted in Docket C-3257 on October 26, 2004.

Description of the Transaction:

According to the application, WCS and Digizip entered into an Asset Purchase Agreement whereby WCS will acquire substantially all of the assets including customers of Digizip. A copy of the asset purchase agreement was provided with the application. Upon consummation of the transaction and approval

by the Commission, Digizip will thereafter cease operations in Nebraska. Digizip requests cancellation of its certificate of authority and its tariffs upon approval of this transaction.

In support of their application, the joint Applicants state the proposed acquisition will not have any impact on Digizip's customers in terms of the services they presently receive. Specifically, Digizip's customers will not experience a change in rates, terms or conditions of services. Digizip's customers will be notified of this change consistent with applicable law requiring notification. A copy of the sample customer notice was provided with the application.

Further, according to the joint Applicants, the acquisition will serve to create a heightened level of operating efficiency which generally will serve to enhance the overall capacity of WCS to compete in the marketplace and provide telecommunications services for a greater number of consumers in Nebraska at competitive rates.

Based upon the above information, the Commission finds the application to be fair and reasonable and in the public interest. Therefore, the application should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-4598 be, and it is hereby, granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the joint Applicants shall provide written notice to the Commission upon consummation of the transaction.
