## O P I N I O N      A N D      F I N D I N G S

On September 17, 2013, United Telephone Company of the West d/b/a CenturyLink (CenturyLink) of Denver, Colorado, filed an application seeking approval of its Interconnection Agreement with MegaPath Corporation (MegaPath) of San Jose, California. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on September 20, 2013. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

CenturyLink and MegaPath entered into a Master Resale Agreement for the State of Nebraska through voluntary negotiations. An executed copy of the Agreement is contained within the application.

The Agreement does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the Agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the Interconnection Agreement should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Interconnection Agreement between United Telephone Company of the West d/b/a CenturyLink and MegaPath Corporation, be, and it is hereby, approved.
