## OPINION AND FINDINGS

On September 17, 2013, United Telephone Company of the West d/b/a CenturyLink (CenturyLink) of Denver, Colorado, an application seeking approval of Interconnection Agreement with MegaPath Corporation Jose, California. San of (MegaPath) of Notice application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on September 20, 2013. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

CenturyLink and MegaPath entered into a Master Resale Agreement for the State of Nebraska through voluntary negotiations. An executed copy of the Agreement is contained within the application.

The Agreement does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the Agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the Interconnection Agreement should be approved.
