On March 10, 2014, an application was filed by Keystone-Arthur Telephone Company (Keystone) of Blue Hill, Nebraska, seeking approval of a name change from Keystone-Arthur Telephone Company to Glenwood Network Services, Inc. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 12, 2014. No protests were filed; therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N     A N D     F I N D I N G S

Keystone is a Nebraska corporation and provides local exchange telecommunication services in Nebraska. In the present application, Keystone requests that the Commission enter an order approving a name change from Keystone-Arthur Telephone Company to Glenwood Network Services, Inc. Keystone has received authority from the Secretary of State to use the new name. Based on all the evidence adduced, the Commission is of the opinion the application is in the public interest and should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-4666 be, and it is hereby, granted and the request of Keystone-Arthur Telephone Company, to change its name to Glenwood Network Services, Inc., is approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Applicant file an updated tariff reflecting the change in name within 30 days of the date of this order.
