O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

This matter comes before the Commission on the Motion of TAG Mobile, LLC ("TAG"), through newly retained Nebraska counsel, filed on March 12, 2015, requesting a second extension of the compliance deadline established in my previous order dated February 19, 2015. TAG requests an extension to March 27, 2015. N.E. Colorado Cellular Inc. d/b/a Viaero Wireless (Viaero), a party to this proceeding, has objected to the Motion for Extension.

Upon consideration of TAG's Motion, I am of the opinion and find a second extension of time should be granted. The revised deadline for TAG to demonstrate compliance shall be **March 27, 2015**. I have suspended this proceeding pending the satisfactory compliance with my previous discovery ruling, thus I find Viaero will not be prejudiced by this additional extension. I caution TAG, however, that as Hearing Officer I have heard, considered and ruled upon the disputed discovery requests and proposed amendments to the Protective Order. To be in compliance with my prior order, TAG must provide the ordered information to counsel for Viaero subject to the terms of the Protective Order entered in this proceeding. TAG may not unilaterally place additional restrictions on the release of this information.
