BY THE COMMISSION:

On August 15, 2014, an application was filed by Teleconnect Long Distance Services and Systems Inc. ("Teleconnect"), Chicago, Illinois, seeking authority to transfer its customers to MCI Communications Services, Inc. d/b/a Verizon Business Services (MCI), Highlands Ranch, Colorado, and cancel its certificate of interexchange authority and tariffs. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on August 20, 2014. No protests were filed; therefore, the Commission processed this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

On October 7, 2014, the Commission granted the application approving the transfer of Teleconnect's customers to MCI. On November 17, 2014, Teleconnect notified the Commission that the transfer had been completed and that it wished to cancel its certificate and accompanying tariffs as a result of the approval granted by the Commission on October 7, 2014. Based on the information provided, we find the request to be fair and reasonable. Accordingly, it should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the certificate of authority held by Teleconnect Long Distance Services and Systems Inc. and accompanying tariffs shall, be and are hereby cancelled.
