BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed September 30, 2014, CTI Long Distance, Inc. ("CTI"), of Portland, Oregon, seeks to withdraw its authority to offer interexchange telecommunications services and to cancel its tariffs in the State of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on October 2, 2014. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N     A N D     F I N D I N G S

By virtue of the authority granted by the Commission in Docket C-2276, CTI was given the ability to offer interexchange telecommunications services within the State of Nebraska. In a letter received on September 23, 2014, CTI requested the withdrawal of its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity and Tariffs within the State of Nebraska. As of September 1, 2014, CTI had 9 customers in Nebraska. CTI mailed a notice to its customers on September 22, 2014, informing them of its intent to discontinue long distance service. CTI further stated it will refund any unused prepaid charges prior to October 28, 2014, and pay the service charges to other telecommunications companies as a result of this service discontinuance.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that CTI's Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to offer telecommunications services and all applicable tariffs should be cancelled.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-4718 is hereby granted, and the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity granted to CTI Long Distance, Inc. to offer telecommunications service in the State of Nebraska and all applicable tariffs are cancelled.
