BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed February 10, 2015, Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink QC ("CenturyLink") of Denver, Colorado, seeks approval of an ICC Bill and Keep Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement with Cricket Communications, Inc. ("Cricket"), of San Diego, California. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on February 13, 2015. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(a) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), CenturyLink and Cricket entered into an ICC Bill and Keep Amendment to their Interconnection Agreement arrived at through voluntary negotiations. An executed copy of this amendment is contained within the application.

Neither the amendment nor any portion thereof discriminates against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review interconnection agreements adopted by negotiation or arbitration to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment should be approved.
