BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 26, 2015, an application was filed by First Choice Technology, Inc. (Applicant), of Maitland, Florida, seeking authority to operate as an interexchange carrier of telecommunications services within the State of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 31, 2015. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's rule of modified procedure.

O P I N I O N    A N D    F I N D I N G S

Applicant is a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Delaware. Applicant has been authorized by the Secretary of State to operate in Nebraska as a foreign corporation. No officer, director or shareholder having five percent or more of the Applicant's voting securities has been involved in a formal complaint or other investigatory or enforcement proceeding.

Applicant is a switchless non-facilities-based reseller of interexchange telecommunications services providing service utilizing the telecommunications network switching facilities of certificated underlying carriers operating in Nebraska. Applicant proposes to offer resold interexchange long distance telecommunications services suitable for voice and limited data applications. The Applicant does not propose to provide alternative operator services nor require advanced payments or deposits.

Interexchange applications are subject to Commission jurisdiction under Neb. Rev. Stat. § 86-129 and Title 291 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, Chapter 5, Rule 003.12. From examination of the application filed herein, the Commission finds that Applicant has provided all the information required by the Commission, possesses adequate financial resources to provide the proposed service, and possesses adequate technical competency to provide the proposed service. The application should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-4751 be, and it is hereby, granted and First Choice Technology, Inc., is authorized to operate as an interexchange carrier of telecommunications services within the State of Nebraska.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, to the extent applicable, the Applicant shall comply with all laws pertaining to, and all rules and regulations promulgated under, the Telecommunications Relay System Act (Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 86-301 to 86-315) and the Nebraska Telecommunications Universal Service Fund Act (Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 86-316 to 86-329).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Applicant file its current tariff prior to offering service pursuant to the certificate granted in this order.

IT IS FINALLY ORDERED that this order be, and it is hereby made, the Commission's official certificate of authority to furnish the service authorized herein as a common carrier.
