BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed April 28, 2015, Telenational Communications, Inc., (TCI), Atlanta, Georgia, is seeking authority to withdraw its certificate of authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services in the State of Nebraska, previously approved in Docket C-2432. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on May 1, 2015. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On April 3, 2001, TCI was granted authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services within the State of Nebraska pursuant to Docket C-2432.

By application received on April 28, 2015, TCI requested the withdrawal of its authority to operate as an interexchange carrier of telecommunications services in the State of Nebraska. TCI has no facilities in Nebraska and provides no telecommunications service in Nebraska.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that TCI's authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services in the State of Nebraska should be cancelled and its tariffs withdrawn.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-4760 be, and it is hereby, granted and the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide interexchange telecommunications services previously granted to Telenational Communications, Inc., is cancelled.
