O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

WiMacTel, Inc., is a local exchange and interexchange provider of telecommunications in Nebraska. In the present application, WiMacTel, Inc., requests that the Commission enter an order approving a name change to WiMacTel, Inc. d/b/a Intellicall Operator Services. WiMacTel has received authority from the Secretary of State to use the new name. Based on all the evidence adduced, the Commission is of the opinion the application is in the public interest and should be granted.
