## OPINION AND FINDINGS

On March 18, 2016, Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink QC, ("CenturyLink") of Denver, Colorado, filed an application seeking approval of its Interconnection Agreement with Windstream KDL, Inc. ("Windstream KDL"), of Little Rock, Arkansas. Notice of the application was published in <a href="The Daily Record">The Daily Record</a>, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 21, 2016. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(a) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), CenturyLink and Windstream KDL entered into an Interconnection Agreement arrived at through voluntary negotiations. An executed copy of the Agreement is contained within the application.

The Agreement does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the Agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the Agreement should be approved.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Interconnection Agreement between Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink QC and Windstream KDL, Inc., be, and it is hereby, approved.
