## OPINIONS AND FINDINGS

On July 21, 2016, Qwest Communications d/b/a CenturyLink QC, United Telephone Company of the West d/b/a CenturyLink (CenturyLink) and Dex Media, Inc., (Dex Media) (collectively Petitioners) filed an application seeking a waiver of requirements for paper publication of directories based in part on the availability of digital alternatives. Petitioners complied with Notice requirements and no protests were received. The Commission held a workshop on October 18, 2016, to discuss the need for this type of waiver and the purposes served.

On November 29, 2016, the Commission issued an Order granting this request subject to conditions. On April 18, 2017, the Commission agreed to modify those conditions. In that Order, the Commission directed the joint petitioners to work with Commission staff on the proposed bill notice to consumers. On May 8, 2017, the Petitioners provided a copy of the draft bill notice to the Commission. Upon review of the bill message, the Commission is of the opinion and finds it to be acceptable. Accordingly, it should
