## BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed July 27, 2016, Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink QC ("CenturyLink"), of Denver, Colorado, seeks approval of a Type 2 Wireless Interconnection Agreement with Emergency Networks, LLC, a Wireless Service Provider ("WSP") out of Boulder, Colorado. Notice of the application was published in <a href="The Daily Record">The Daily Record</a>, Omaha, Nebraska, on August 1, 2016. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(a) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), CenturyLink and WSP entered into an Interconnection Agreement arrived at through voluntary negotiations. An executed copy of this agreement is contained within the application.

Neither the agreement nor any portion thereof discriminates against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review interconnection agreements adopted by negotiation or arbitration to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the Interconnection Agreement should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Interconnection Agreement between Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink QC and Emergency Networks, LLC, be, and it is hereby, approved.
