BY THE COMMISSION:

By Application filed August 12, 2016, Alliance Group Services, Inc. ("AGSI"), of Westport, Connecticut, seeks to withdraw its authority to offer interexchange telecommunications services and to cancel its tariffs in the State of Nebraska. Notice of the Application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on August 18, 2016. No protests were filed; therefore, this Application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

By virtue of the authority granted by the Commission in Docket C-1872, AGSI was given the ability to offer interexchange telecommunications services within the State of Nebraska. In an application received on August 12, 2016, AGSI requested the withdrawal of its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity and Tariffs within the State of Nebraska. As of August 12, 2016, AGSI had no customers in Nebraska.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that AGSI's Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to offer telecommunications services and all applicable tariffs should be cancelled.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-4865 is hereby granted, and the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity granted to Alliance Group Services, Inc., to offer telecommunications service in the State of Nebraska and all applicable tariffs are cancelled.
