BY THE COMMISSION:

On August 16, 2016, an application was filed by GoDaddy.com, LLC ("GoDaddy.com" or "Applicant"), of Scottsdale, Arizona, seeking authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services within the State of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on August 22, 2016. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Applicant is a limited liability company organized under the laws of the State of Delaware authorized to do business in the State of Nebraska. Applicant's principal place of business is located in Scottsdale, Arizona. Applicant states no officer, director or shareholder has been involved in a formal complaint or other investigatory or enforcement proceeding within the last two years.

Applicant does not currently provide telecommunications service, but is in the process of applying for authorization or registering to provide long distance interexchange and interconnected VoIP services in all fifty states, the District of Columbia, and Puerto Rico.

GoDaddy.com proposes to provide resold interexchange telecommunications services throughout the entire State of Nebraska. Specifically, Applicant will utilize a proprietary interactive voice response ("IVR") and unified messaging platform. Applicant will purchase toll free and direct inward dialing ("DID") numbers, and resells those numbers as part of virtual office service. Small business customers then can use those numbers to access Applicant's integrated suite of additional services and functionality, including: auto attendant, call forwarding/distribution, call queuing, call screening, Internet fax/fax back, and enhanced voicemail capabilities such as voice-to-text conversion and email delivery of voicemails. GoDaddy.com may also provide interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol ("VoIP") services. At the time a customer signs up for service,

Applicant will obtain credit or debit card information from the customer and automatically bill the customer's credit/debit card each month for the invoiced charges.

Applicant states it possesses the necessary technical expertise and management team to serve Nebraska customers. In Exhibit 4 to the application, Applicant provided details of its management's experience.

Applicant further states it possesses the necessary financial ability to provide the proposed service in Nebraska. The most recent financial statements for GoDaddy.com's parent, GoDaddy Inc., were made available in its most recent Form 10-K annual report filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission on March 2, 2016.

Interexchange applications are subject to Commission jurisdiction under Neb. Rev. Stat. § 86-129 and Title 291 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, Chapter 5, Rule 003.12. From examination of the application filed herein, the Commission finds that Applicant has provided all the information required by the Commission, possesses adequate financial resources to provide the proposed service, and possesses adequate technical competency to provide the proposed service. The application should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-4866 be, and it is hereby, granted and GoDaddy.com, LLC is authorized to operate as an interexchange carrier of telecommunications services within the State of Nebraska.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, to the extent applicable, the Applicant shall comply with all laws pertaining to, and all rules and regulations promulgated under, the Telecommunications Relay System Act (Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 86-301 to 86-315) and the Nebraska Telecommunications Universal Service Fund Act (Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 86-316 to 86-329).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Applicant file its current tariff prior to offering service pursuant to the certificate granted in this order.

IT IS FINALLY ORDERED that this order be, and it is hereby made, the Commission's official certificate of authority to furnish the service authorized herein as a common carrier.
