BY THE COMMISSION:

On August 22, 2016, an application was filed by Larry Toben of Doniphan, Nebraska, ("Applicant") seeking a boundary change to receive advanced telecommunications capability service from the adjacent Doniphan Exchange of the Hamilton Telephone Company ("Hamilton") in lieu of Applicant's current service from the Hansen Exchange of Windstream Nebraska, Inc. ("Windstream"). Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on August 25, 2016.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

Hamilton and Windstream are local exchange carriers holding certificates of public convenience and necessity to provide local exchange service in their respective territories. Applicant resides within the boundaries of Windstream's Hansen Exchange, and has requested a boundary change so the Applicant may receive advanced telecommunications capability service from the Doniphan Exchange of Hamilton. Hamilton and Windstream have notified the Commission that they do not oppose the proposed boundary change.

Changes of a local exchange territory are governed by Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 86-135 to 86-138. Section 86-135 states that only upon non-consent of all telephone carriers involved shall the Commission hold a public hearing in the application. With no protest filed by any party and with each of the affected local exchange carriers consenting to the boundary change, Commission processes this application administratively and without a public hearing. Commission staff has modified the relevant exchange maps to show the boundary changes to the Doniphan and Hansen Exchanges. Copies of the exchange maps with the proposed revisions are attached as Appendix "A" to this Order and hereby incorporated by reference. If either Hamilton or Windstream have objections or changes to the proposed boundary maps, they have until October 18, 2016, to contact the Commission with said objections or changes. If the Commission receives no objections or changes from either party by October 18, 2016, the boundary maps shall be modified as proposed in Appendix "A".

The Commission finds that, in light of the consent between the parties involved, the application is in the public interest and should be granted. It is the expectation of the Commission that the two carriers involved in the boundary change shall collaborate in good faith to ensure that the transition of the customer's service from one carrier to the other shall be as seamless as possible.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-4867 be, and it is hereby, granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that on or before October 18, 2016, Hamilton Telephone Company and Windstream Nebraska, Inc., shall contact the Commission with any changes or concerns regarding the boundaries as proposed in Appendix "A" to this order. If no objection is received from either company, the boundaries as shown in Appendix "A" to this order shall be the official boundaries of Hamilton Telephone Company and Windstream Nebraska, Inc.
