## BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed October 21, 2016, Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink (CenturyLink) of Denver, Colorado, seeks approval of a carrier partner for interconnected VoIP provider amendment to its Interconnection Agreement with Level 3 Communications, LLC, (Level 3) of Broomfield, Colorado. Notice of the application was published in <a href="The Daily Record">The Daily Record</a>, Omaha, Nebraska, on October 26, 2016. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

On April 22, 2003, in Docket C-2780, the original Interconnection Agreement between CenturyLink and Level 3 was approved by the Commission. In the current application, CenturyLink seeks to amend the agreement by adding a carrier partner for interconnected VoIP provider amendment to the Interconnection Agreement. An executed copy of the Amendment is contained within the application.
