BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed October 25, 2016, Masergy Communications, Inc., (Masergy Communications) of Plano, Texas, is seeking authority to withdraw its authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services in the State of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on November 2, 2016. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

By virtue of the authority granted by the Commission in Docket C-4415, Masergy Communications was given the ability to offer interexchange telecommunications services within the State of Nebraska. In an application received on October 25, 2016, Masergy Communications requested the withdrawal of its authority to operate as an interexchange carrier of telecommunications services in the State of Nebraska. As of October 24, 2016, Masergy Communications had no customers in Nebraska.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that Masergy Communication's authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services in the State of Nebraska should be cancelled and all applicable tariffs should be cancelled.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-4877 is hereby granted, and the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity granted to Masergy Communications, Inc., to offer telecommunications service in the State of Nebraska and all applicable tariffs are cancelled.
