By application filed November 18, 2016, Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink (CenturyLink) of Denver, Colorado, seeks approval of an amendment to its Interconnection Agreement with Cox Nebraska Telcom, L.L.C., (Cox) of Atlanta, Georgia, providing for a second subloop access at MDUs extension. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on November 23, 2016. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

On January 29, 2008, in Docket C-3796, the original Interconnection Agreement between CenturyLink and Cox was approved by the Commission. In the current application, CenturyLink seeks to amend the agreement by providing for an extension of the subloop access at MDUs. An executed copy of the Amendment is contained within the application.

The Amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the Amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.
