BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed December 21, 2016, Gold Line Telemanagement, Inc. ("Gold Line"), of Ontario, Canada, seeks to withdraw its authority to offer interexchange telecommunications services and to cancel its tariffs in the State of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on December 23, 2016. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

By virtue of the authority granted by the Commission in Docket C-4218, Gold Line was given the ability to offer interexchange telecommunications services within the State of Nebraska. In an application received on December 21, 2016, Gold Line requested the withdrawal of its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide interexchange service in Nebraska and its tariffs. Gold Line has no facilities or customers in Nebraska and provides no telecommunications service in Nebraska.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that Gold Line's Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to offer telecommunications services and all applicable tariffs should be cancelled.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-4884 is hereby granted, and the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity granted to Gold Line Telemanagement, Inc., to offer telecommunications service in the State of Nebraska and all applicable tariffs are cancelled.
