BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed December 21, 2016, OneLink Communications, Inc. ("OneLink"), of Tamarac, Florida, seeks to withdraw its authority to offer interexchange telecommunications services and to cancel its tariffs in the State of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on December 23, 2016. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

By virtue of the authority granted by the Commission in Docket C-2952, OneLink was given the ability to offer interexchange telecommunications services within the State of Nebraska. In an application received on December 21, 2016, OneLink requested the withdrawal of its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity and Tariffs within the State of Nebraska. As of December 2016, OneLink had ceased all operations in Nebraska. Before termination of business, OneLink did notify all Nebraska long distance customers of the termination and assisted them with finding another long distance carrier.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that OneLink's Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to offer telecommunications services and all applicable tariffs should be cancelled.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-4886 is hereby granted, and the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity granted to OneLink Communications, Inc., to offer telecommunications service in the State of Nebraska and all applicable tariffs are cancelled.
