By application filed March 7, 2017, Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink QC (CenturyLink), of Denver, Colorado, seeks approval of a Carrier Partner for Interconnected VoIP Provider Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement with Airus, Inc. (Airus), of Chicago, Illinois, previously approved in Docket C-4733. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 9, 2017. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.
