#### BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed April 21, 2017, OrbitCom, Inc., ("OrbitCom") of Sioux Falls, South Dakota, seeks to withdraw its authority to offer interexchange telecommunications services and to cancel its tariffs in the State of Nebraska. Notice of the Application was published in <a href="The Daily Record">The Daily Record</a>, Omaha, Nebraska, on April 25, 2017. No protests were filed; therefore, this Application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

#### OPINION AND FINDINGS

By virtue of the authority granted by the Commission in Docket C-2776, OrbitCom was given the ability to offer interexchange telecommunications services within the State of Nebraska. In an application received on April 21, 2017, OrbitCom requested the withdrawal of its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity and Tariffs within the State of Nebraska. OrbitCom has no customers or business operations in Nebraska.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that OrbitCom's Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to offer telecommunications services and all applicable tariffs should be cancelled.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-4920 is hereby granted, and the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity granted to OrbitCom, Inc. to offer telecommunications service in the State of Nebraska and all applicable tariffs are cancelled.
