BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed April 24, 2017, Opcom, Inc., d/b/a WCS Telecom, ("Opcom") of Billings, Montana, seeks to withdraw its authority to offer interexchange telecommunications services and to cancel its tariffs in the State of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on April 28, 2017. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

By virtue of the authority granted by the Commission in Docket C-3546, Opcom was given the ability to offer interexchange telecommunications services within the State of Nebraska. In an application received on April 24, 2017, Opcom requested the withdrawal of its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity and Tariffs within the State of Nebraska. As of December 2016, Opcom had ceased all operations in Nebraska. Before termination of business, Opcom did notify all Nebraska long distance customers of the termination and assisted them with finding another long distance carrier.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that Opcom's Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to offer telecommunications services and all applicable tariffs should be cancelled.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-4922 is hereby granted, and the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity granted to Opcom, Inc., d/b/a WCS Telecom to offer telecommunications service in the State of Nebraska and all applicable tariffs are cancelled.
