## BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed August 7, 2017, Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink (CenturyLink) of Denver, Colorado, seeks approval of an amendment to its Interconnection Agreement with Airus, Inc., (Airus) of Chicago, Illinois. Notice of the application was published in <a href="The Daily Record">The Daily Record</a>, Omaha, Nebraska, on August 9, 2017. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

On February 3, 2015, in Docket C-4733, the original Interconnection Agreement between CenturyLink and Airus was approved by the Commission. In the current application, CenturyLink seeks to amend the agreement through a Reciprocal Compensation Bill and Keep Amendment and a Third Party Provider Amendment. Executed copies of the Amendments are contained within the application.

The Amendments do not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the Amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the Amendment should be approved.
