By application filed October 26, 2017, Windstream Nebraska, Inc. ("Windstream"), of Little Rock, Arkansas seeks approval of an Interconnection Agreement with Broadview Networks, Inc. ("Broadview"), of Little Rock, Arkansas. Notice of the application was published in <a href="The Daily Record">The Daily Record</a>, Omaha, Nebraska, on November 1, 2017. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(a) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), Windstream and Broadview entered into an Interconnection Agreement arrived at through voluntary negotiations. An executed copy of this agreement is contained within the application.
