BY THE COMMISSION:

By original complaint dated May 14, 2018, the Communications Department (Department) of the Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) initiated this docket requesting the Commission to administratively fine and/or revoke the operating authority of various interexchange and local exchange telecommunications companies for failure to file annual reports pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 86-159. All such companies who had not filed annual reports with the Commission, who had filed incomplete annual reports, or who had not paid fines for filing their annual reports after the April 30th deadline were named as respondents in this docket. A copy of the Complaint and the Order to Show Cause was mailed to each defendant via certified United States mail.

The respondents named in the complaint are interexchange (IXC) and local exchange (LEC) telecommunications companies generally regulated by the Commission, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 75-101 et. seq. and §§ 86-101 et. seq. Respondents are also governed by 291 Neb. Admin. Code, Chapter 5, of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. Each of the respondents was required to file a complete annual report and payment with the Commission before April 30th, 2018, but failed to do so despite repeated communications from Commission staff.

The companies listed below have signed a stipulation with the Department wherein each defendant admits to filing its report late and has paid an administrative fine to dismiss the departmental complaint:

Access Point, Inc. ("Access Point");
Charter Fiberlink - Nebraska, LLC ("Charter");
DishNET Wireline, LLC ("DishNET");
GoDaddy.com, LLC ("GoDaddy");
Huntel Communications, Inc. ("Huntel");

**IDT America Corp. ("IDT");
Peerless Network of Nebraska, LLC ("Peerless"); and
Spectrotel, Inc. d/b/a One Touch Communications
("Spectrotel").**

The Commission finds that the signed stipulations are satisfactory and therefore the above-listed respondents should be dismissed from the complaint.

Each above-listed respondent to be dismissed from the Complaint pursuant to this Order is hereby advised that this Commission will not tolerate similar behavior in 2019 regarding the filing of the company's 2018 annual report. If reports are not received by the Commission on or before April 30, 2018, the option of resolving the complaint through a stipulation will be closely scrutinized. All companies that have agreed to such a stipulation will be considered a willful violator and will be subject to additional penalties and/or administrative sanctions.

In addition to the companies listed above, respondents **OPEX Communications, Inc. d/b/a TCI Long Distance ("OPEX"), Norstan Network Services, Inc. d/b/a Netwolves Network Services, LLC ("Norstan"), and Newcastle Holdings, Inc. ("Newcastle")** were included in the complaint due to administrative error. The Commission finds that Newcastle, Norstan and OPEX should also be dismissed from the complaint.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that **Access Point, Inc., Charter Fiberlink - Nebraska, LLC, DishNET Wireline, LLC, GoDaddy.com, LLC, Huntel Communications, Inc., IDT America Corp., Peerless Network of Nebraska, Inc., Spectrotel, Inc., Norstan Network Services, Inc., Newcastle Holdings, Inc., and OPEX Communications, Inc.** be, and hereby are, dismissed from the departmental complaint in Application No. C-4983 / DC-93.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any respondent who subsequently files a satisfactory annual report may execute a stipulation with the department similar to that offered to the above-named company in an effort to obtain dismissal.
