BY THE COMMISSION:

On January 15, 2019, NobelTel, LLC ("Applicant") of Carlsbad, California, filed an application seeking cancellation of its authority to operate as an interexchange carrier or telecommunications services and to cancel its tariff in the State of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on January 18, 2019. No protests or interventions were filed; therefore, this application is being processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

FINDINGS AND OPINION

The Applicant in this docket was originally granted authority to provide interexchange services in Nebraska in Commission Docket Nos. C-2960 and C-3968. In its application, Applicant requests cancellation of this authority on the basis that it currently has no customers for wireline services in Nebraska.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that Applicant's Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to offer telecommunications services and all applicable tariffs should be cancelled.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-5030 is hereby granted, and the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity granted to NobelTel, LLC to offer telecommunications service in the State of Nebraska, and all applicable tariffs, are cancelled.


