## BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed January 22, 2019, Onvoy, LLC ("Onvoy"), of Plymouth, Minnesota seeks approval of an interconnection agreement with Windstream Nebraska, Inc. ("Windstream"). Notice of the application was published in <a href="The Daily Record">The Daily Record</a>, Omaha, Nebraska, on January 22, 2019. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Pursuant to the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 ("the Act"), specifically 47 U.S.C. § 252(a), Onvoy and Windstream entered into an Interconnection Agreement arrived at through voluntary negotiations. An executed copy of this agreement is contained within the application.

Neither the agreement nor any portion thereof discriminates against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review Interconnection Agreements adopted by negotiation or arbitration to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the Commission finds that this Interconnection Agreement should be approved.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Interconnection Agreement between Onvoy, LLC, and Windstream Nebraska, Inc. shall be, and is hereby, approved.
