BY THE COMMISSION:

The City of Minden (Applicant), Minden, Nebraska, by its application filed January 24, 2002, sought authority to construct, operate and maintain an electric transmission line in Kearney County, Nebraska, having a voltage in excess of 700 volts.

Applicant proposed to construct 0.43 mile, 3 phase, 4 wire overhead, $2.4/4.16~{\rm kv}$, Wye connected, multigrounded electric line in Kearney County.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

The Commission finds that based upon notification from Applicant, the route of the proposed transmission line has been annexed by the City of Minden.

Therefore, as the proposed route lies in an area annexed by the City of Minden, the Commission lacks jurisdiction over this matter.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. E-1941 be dismissed as the proposed route for the transmission line has been annexed by the City of Minden and the Commission lacks jurisdiction to act on the application.
