OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed July 25, 2006, the Nebraska Public Power District, Columbus, sought authority to construct, operate and maintain an electric transmission line in Stanton, Wayne and Cedar Counties, having a voltage in excess of 700 volts.

On August 8, 2006, this application was granted and Applicant was duly notified that such action had been taken.

On May 16, 2008, Applicant notified this Commission by mail that the authorized construction had not been completed and Applicant requested 10 months extension of time be granted for the completion of this line construction as submitted under the original application.

After due consideration of Applicant's request and being fully advised in the premises, pursuant to Rule 002.07C of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, which authorizes this action, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that Applicant's request should be granted and that the authority granted in Docket E-2121 be extended for a period of 10 months to June 8, 2009.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Applicant's request be, and it is hereby, granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the authority granted in Docket E-2121 be extended and that the Nebraska Public Power District, Columbus, be given an extension of time to June 8, 2009, to complete the construction of the electric transmission line in Stanton, Wayne and Cedar Counties.
